To immunise is to make someone safe against disease(s) by putting certain substances into the body. The substances which are put in the body are known as vaccines. The process of giving the substances is known as immunization or vaccination. Every child needs to be vaccinated to get protection against these dangerous diseases. The process of immunization begins immediately after a baby is born. A child is immunised by being given vaccines which can be injected into the body or given by mouth. All immunizations are given in the first year of its child's life. A child who is not immunized is more likely to suffer from these killer diseases than the one who has been immunized.

The baby should be taken for immunization five times in the first year of their life. At birth or as soon as possible afterwards, babies should be immunized against T.B. The first dose of polio vaccine can also be given at this time. For T.B, a child is given a single vaccine known as BCG injection on the right hand shoulder. T.B vaccines cause a sore and leaves a scar.
