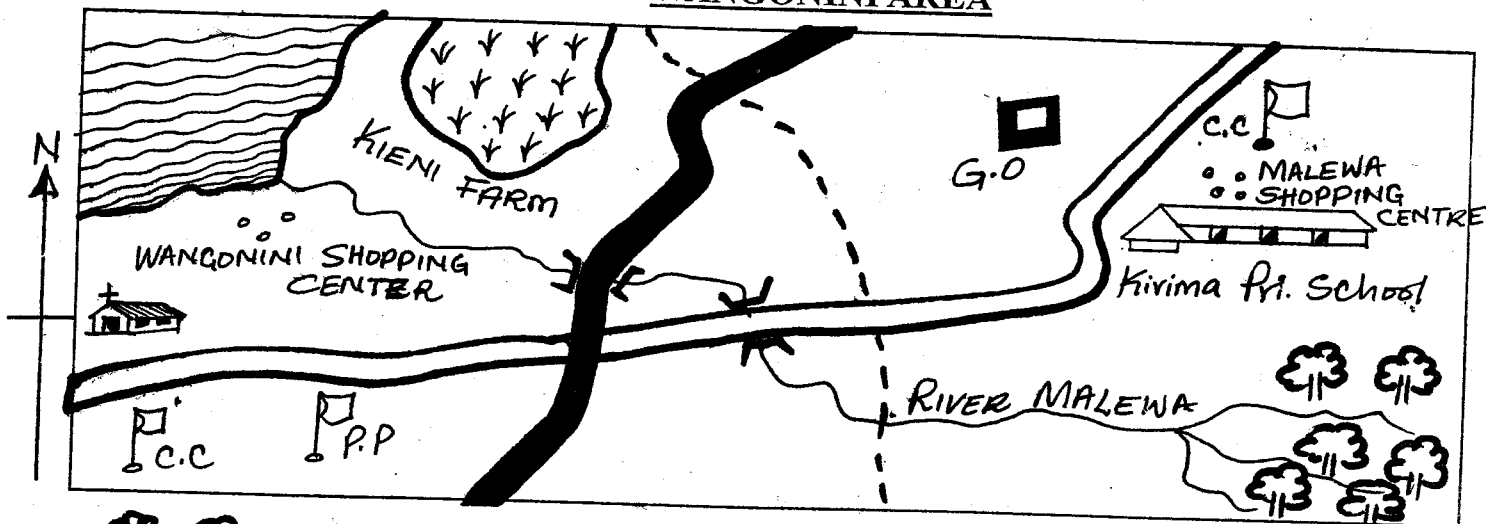

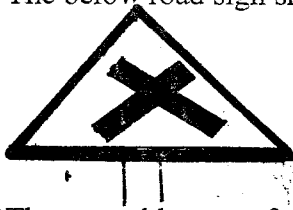
Forest Locational boundary Lake
